Contest Site

The site is used for model aerobatics only. There is one runway, 100 meters long and 10 meters wide, also short grass between the runway, the preparation area and all other buildings.
Registration and model processing will basically take place at the headquarters on Contest Site as will the Team Manager meeting.

Temperature

Plan on winds of up to 10 km/h and temperatures of 20 to 25 degrees Centigrade.

Language**

English and German. The working languages to be used for interpretation of rules and for settlement of matters in dispute shall be English or German.

**Classifi-
cation**

Individual competition and
Team competition.

FAI Licence Each competitor must have a valid FAI-Sporting Licence, obtained from his/her National Aero Club. This licence is to be presented during registration prior to flying in the competition.

Protest Fee A protest may be submitted according to the FAI-Sporting Code, accompanied by AS 300,- refundable if the protest is upheld.

Participation Every member of the FAI may enter a National Team. For F3C - a Team Manager, three individual competitors.

Competition Rules 1989 FAI Sporting Code, Section 4a, part five, Class F3C (5.4), together with all applicable General Rules and Regulations, including rule changes approved up to the time of the CIAM Plenary meeting March 1991.
