The Aero Club Aeromodellistico Milano Est (ACAME) acts on Aero Club of Italy (AeCI)' authority invite all European FAI affiliated National Air Sport Control Organizations to join with a team in the **14th FAI World Championship for helicopters model F3C** for the year 2011 on the following terms:

Participation

Every FAI affiliated National Aero Club (National Airsport Control Organization) may enter a Team consisting of one Team Manager, one Team Manager's Assistant/trainer, three Pilots and helpers, in agreement with 2011 FAI Sporting Code Section 4. Supporters from each participating country are welcome to the event. The reigning World Champion, Mr. Ito Hiroki, is invited to defend his title.

Organisers

The 2011 F3C FAI World Championships Organizing Committee of Aero Club Aeromodellistico Milano Est (ACAME) in agreement with Aero Club of Italy (AeCI), Comune di Calcinato, Provincia di Brescia, Regione Lombardia, with the sponsorship Federazione Italiana Aero Modellismo (FIAM), invites to join with a team in the **14th FAI World Championship for helicopters model F3C**.

Site location

The F3C World Championships will be held Calcinatello di Calcinato (BS), on the Aeromodelling site called "Casa Bianca" equipped with two parallel flying fields placed at a distance of about 500 meters from each other. The "Casa Bianca" is located 7 km away from the shore of the beautiful Garda Lake, 5 km west of the city of Brescia in Italy.

Field elevation: 171 meters above sea level

How to reach Calcinatello di Calcinato (BS) :

By car : from the North - Highway A4 - exit Brescia Est (Casa Bianca 5

km. away) (*)


By plane : Orio al Serio Intern. Airport (BG) 60 km

Villafranca Intern. Airport (VR) 40 km Linate Intern. Airport (MI) 110 km. Malpensa Intern. Airport (VA) 140 km. Montichiari Airport (BS) 10 km.

(*) After the Brescia Est motorway toll-house, take the route to Montichiari, cross the motorway from above, follow the "Casa Bianca" and "CdM F3C" signs. Go down to the right and follow the "Civilenghe" sign. Cross the roundabout and, after the Stop

sign, turn left: always follow the "Casa Bianca" and "CdM F3C" signs. Climb the bridge, turn right and keep following the above signs until you reach the Casa Bianca restaurant.






Vehicle Rental

Practice Sites


Five practice sites will be available around the World Championships area within a distance of 60 km. Detailed maps will be made available in Bulletin 3.

Competition Rules

In agreement with FAI Sporting Code, Section 4, 2011 Edition as well as all applicable amendments.

Protests

All protests must be presented in writing to the Contest Director at the competition site and must be accompanied by a deposit of 35 EUR.

The deposit is returned if the protest is upheld only.

Anti-doping

In case a competitor has to take any of the substances listed on the WADA Prohibited List for medical treatment then must have Therapeutic Use Exemption from the FAI.

FAI Specification Certificate

Each Competitor must present a properly completed FAI Specification Certificate for each model entered in agreement with the FAI Sporting Code. These certificates must be certified and stamped by the National Aero Club (National Airsport Control). Models submitted for registration which do not have the proper FAI Certificates and stickers shall be processed by the Organizer at a cost of € 8,00 each.

Awards

FAI medals and diploma will be awarded to the winner, second and third place competitors and teams. The Challenge Trophy, presently hold by Hiroki Ito (Japan), will be awarded to the winner of the competition.

The Challenge Trophy for team presently hold by USA, will be awarded to the best classified nation of the competition.

Official Language

Official Languages are English and Italian

Insurance

The Organizers will arrange an insurance policy covering all pilots for model accident involving injury to others and damage to property.

The Organizers are not responsible for any other injury, loss, theft or damage to person or property. Personal and travel insurance purchased before arriving in Italy is recommended.

Entry Fees

- € 450,00 per Competitor. This covers participation to the World Championships, access to the flight line, entry to Opening Ceremony and reception, souvenirs and gifts.
- € 450,00 per Team Manager or official trainer. This covers participation to the World Championships, access to the flight line, entry to Opening Ceremony and reception, souvenirs and gifts.

- € 90,00 per Helper or Mechanic. This covers participation to World Championships, access to the flight line, entry to opening ceremony and reception, souvenirs and gifts.
- € 80,00 per Supporter. This covers participation to the World Championship, entry to opening ceremony and reception, souvenirs and gifts. Crowd and supporters circulation inside that same area will be free everywhere except for the competition post. Several car parking lots will be available.

Accommodation

- A) Currency will be Euro only
- B) Two hotels have been reserved for the F3C World Championships with agreements for special prices. Reservations must be placed with 2011 F3C World Championships organizers (paola@fiamaero.it). Please tell us whether you need a single or double room in your hotel of choice.
- C) Lunch will be held at the excellent and natural "Casa Bianca" restaurant and will include self-service vegetables, a choice of first course, a choice of second course, dessert, a quarter of a litre of water and quarter of a litre of Italian wine.
- D) Dinner will be held at the hotel chosen by you and will include a choice of first course, a choice of second course, dessert, a quarter of a litre of water and quarter of a litre of Italian wine.

However, only countries which return the preliminary entry form before February 28 will receive Bulletin 2 and the official entry form

Enrolments must be made using the attached form, must include general biographical notes about the contestants and a color photograph in JPEG format (300 dpi maximum), and must be received via e-mail by FIAM on or before May 30, 2011. Late entries and payments, received after May 30, 2011, will be subject to a 50% surcharge.

The organisers will confirm receipt of entries shortly after the closing date.
